The 93rd Bomb Group was the most decorated, most traveled and most effective bomb group of WWII. Crippling Hitler's Europe from the air, they executed some of the most daring bombing raids in the war. Along with the group's rich history, sons, daughters and grandchildren travel to England and explore the 93rd's long forgotten airbase - Hardwick Aerodrome 104.

Director's Statement

This project is very close to me. My grandfather was a veteran of World War II and eighteen years ago I attended my first 93rd Bomb Group reunion in England with him. I was awestruck at finding out what he did as a bombardier during the war. A twenty year old kid flying high above enemy territory in an oversized tin can and at the same time dropping 500 pound bombs into the sky. On top of that, finishing a 35 mission tour and returning home alive was beyond impressive. I got hooked on the 93rd's story and my grandfather's connection to it.

Return to Hardwick is a respectful look at a moment in history. It focuses on the descendants of the 93rd who return to stand on the site of the former compound where their relatives were stationed. The film is professionally edited and photographed. Many of the interviews invoke honest emotions, but manage to avoid sentimentality. The movie is a fitting tribute to the heroes of World War II who changed history for the good.

The film shows a remarkable assortment of historical photos and does a good job of blending them in with modern footage. Several sequences pair historical with modern photos, making the modern scene come alive for the viewer. As Americans are acknowledging the importance of WW2 history even as we are losing our last living links to that conflict, it is easy for documentaries to become mawkish. This one does a good job of letting the sacrifices of the combatants and their families speak for themselves.
